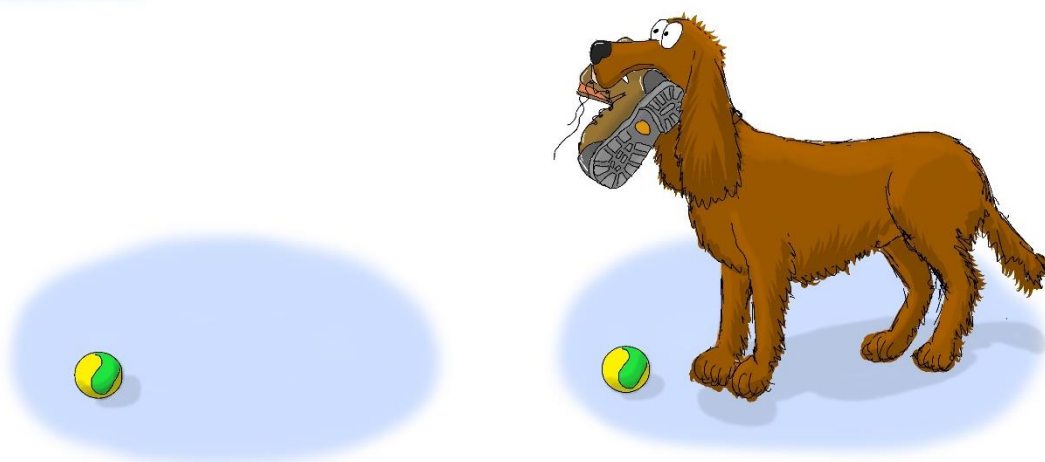
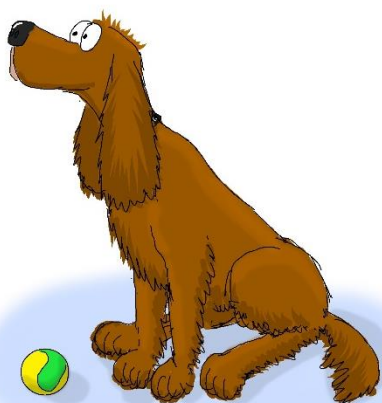

# No! vet-bah!

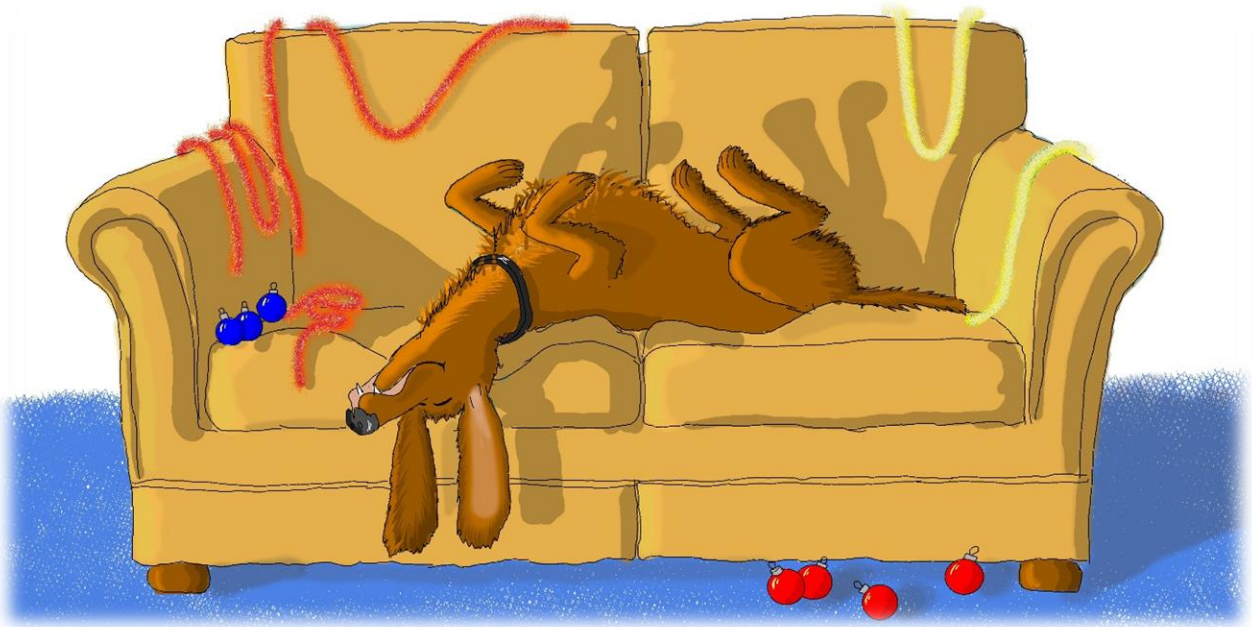
